Personal Photos:

Photos are meant to be for your personal use only, not for commercial purposes or public viewing.

Absolutely no video cameras.

Other Policies:

No Stallions, Mules, or Donkeys allowed. Appropriate footwear is required at all times during your private lesson.

Payment Policy:

50% of fees are required at sign up. Private lesson must be paid in full 30 days prior to start date. This includes all travel expenses. Payments must be made to JRD Horsemanship, 454 North Tacoma Street, Farmington, AR 72730. Contact JRD Horsemanship at 386-249-1742 for more details.

Refund Policy:

If you need to cancel, efforts will be made by JRD Horsemanship to fill your lesson dates with another private lesson. JRD Horsemanship reserves this right. If your dates are filled, your fees will be returned minus administration fees. All cancellations are subject to:

- **Cancellation 90 days before the clinic:** 50% deposit refunded.
- **Cancellation 90-30 days before clinic:** 25% deposit refunded less \$250 administration fee.
- **Cancellation 30 days or fewer before clinic:** No refund.

Cancellation Policy:

JRD Horsemanship reserves the right to cancel a lesson due to unforeseen circumstances beyond our control. Such decisions will be made at least two weeks before the scheduled private lesson date. If a lesson is canceled by JRD Horsemanship, you will be entitled to a full lesson refund.

Travel Expenses:

All travel reservations are made by JRD Horsemanship. Every effort to find the most reasonable and cost effective method of travel is made for each private lesson. The Professional Clinician offers the option of lodging with the private lesson host to reduce cost. Also, the host may provide transportation to and from the airport. Host is responsible for Professional Clinician meals. A standard \$200 fee is added to travel expenses for parking and mileage to the airport. The Professional Clinician will work with each private lesson host on these details.

Application Policy:

This application needs to be completed by each participant in the private lesson and provided to the Professional Clinician 30 days prior to the private lesson start date.
